The College of Health Sciences offers undergraduate degrees in Exercise Science, Music Therapy, Nursing, and Public Health and graduate degrees are available in Art Therapy, Athletic Training, Health and Human Performance, kinesiology, Music Therapy, Nursing (FNP, PHMNP, WHNP, NE) and Doctor in Nursing Practice. Eight minors are offered.

As Associate Dean, I served as the Assessment Coordinator for the College and oversaw the Comprehensive Program Reviews. I handled student issues, had oversight of all curriculum development and changes within the College, and oversight of the obtainment of clinical sites for the entire College and issuances of Memorandums of Understandings (MOUs) for those locations. I was involved in forming the University's electronic Tenure and Promotion platform and represented the CoHS at numerous campus events and recruiting efforts. This year, I was appointed by the President to serve on a yearlong project to study faculty salaries within the University and recommend adjustments based on national standards.

### **Assistant Director over Graduate Programs, School of Nursing**

August 2015 – August 2017 (left position to serve as Interim Associate Dean) then returned August 2019 to this position.

In this position I have oversight of the School of Nursing's graduate programs which include MSN degrees in Family Nurse Practitioner, Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner, Women's Health Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Educator and a soon to open Nurse Midwifery program. Post MSN certificates are available in all areas. The School of Nursing also offers a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree. My responsibilities include recruitment efforts, admissions, curriculum development, graduate faculty oversight and development, maintaining accreditation standards, working with the program directors to submit Institutional Effectiveness Reports.

I authored and serve as the Project Director (PI) on Georgia College's 2017 and 2019 HRSA ANEW Grants. I have direct oversight of all activities on these grants, which includes a budget of \$4.2 million and four faculty and staff members. As the Project Director, I work with State and National leaders to help improve access to care in rural and medically underserved areas of Georgia. We were the only school in Georgia to receive the 2019 ANEW Grant.
