The Georgia College School of Nursing Advisory Board provides a venue for communication and collaboration between the nursing education programs and public stakeholders. This exchange of information is utilized to enhance the school's educational programs, resources, and community relationships in fulfilling the GCSU School of Nursing mission.

Purposes:

- To assist the School of Nursing in identifying regional and global trends and projections with society and industry that impact the school.
- To serve as advocates/liaisons for the School of Nursing with internal and external constituent groups.
- To assist the School of Nursing in identifying and acquiring financial resources and external support essential to the program's continued success.
- To develop and maintain an alumni database.

Members:

Members will include (a) representatives from the GCSU campus community whose programs, courses, and functions directly impact the School of Nursing; and (b) community leaders including representatives from clinical agencies, GCSU nursing program alumni, and (c) our liaison from Georgia Military College.

The SON leadership team will serve as ex-officio members of the Board.

Meetings:

The Director of the School of Nursing will convene the group once a semester.

The administrative assistant to the Director will take minutes at each meeting.

The meetings will be held in Milledgeville in the Fall semester and in Macon in the Spring semester.

Any committee member may submit an agenda item to the Director. An agenda will be circulated to the committee members at least two weeks in advance of the meeting.
