Explanation for Criterion IV D.1 and D.2

D.1 The MSN program currently has established criteria which students must meet prior to (prerequisite) or concomitantly with (corequisite) enrolling, receiving transfer credit for, or being exempted from didactic coursework.

D.2 The MSN program ensures that students meet the program's established prerequisite or corequisite criteria prior to or concomitantly with enrolling in, or being exempted from, midwifery didactic coursework.

The same procedures will be enforced for the midwifery program as for the existing MSN programs. Students are admitted once a year in a cohort model. All students receive a planned program of study that is detailed and ensures that all pre and co requisites are met. Any variation from the original program of study requires a petition (transfer credits) or in the case of post masters certificate students a gap analysis.

Student progression is detailed using an online system called Degree Works. Screen shot is included in this exhibit. Students must apply for graduation and a review is done to ensure that all requirements are met.
